The HOD meeting was conducted on **06**th **June 2017** at the Principals chamber. All the departments presented their work done by them in the past 2 months and their future plans.

1. Oral Medicine

Collections of April & May was Rs. 27,798 and Rs. 31,251 respectively. The number of students participation in 4 intercollegiate progress was 31 and no of awards was 5, and No of seminars presented in April, May were 16 and 7 by the students. Salivary Sialic Acid and Fucose as Tumor Markers in Potentially Malignant Disorders is the ongoing student research and 3 staff research projects are also ongoing. All the staff had participated in CDE programs of other colleges. There were 3 special cases of Acute Myeloid Leukemia, Carcinoma of Alveoplus, Speckled Leukoplakia in the department. Future proposals & projects – Proposal for study on Oral awareness among patients and student guidance for MOLARIS 2017.

2. Periodontics

The Collections for April & May was Rs.15,506 and Rs. 28,870 respectively. There was 25 Major Surgeries in the department done by interns including PRF procurement, Esthetic crown lengthening, laser surgery, vestibuloplasty during the month of May. There was one publication in an International journal from the department. There are 6 ongoing research projects. There were 16 student participations in 3 intercollegiate programs with 4 awards. Dr. Juala Catharine attended a workshop on Biostatistics conducted an University. Future program include guest lecturer on Diagnosis for interns in July and planning for Oral hygiene awareness program for Oral Hygiene day on August 1st.

3. Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery

The number of extractions done during April & May were 255 and 239 and Minor surgeries 29 & 34 respectively. There were 8 Major surgeries done under GA during the past 2 months with a collection of Rs. 57,653. There are 5 cases waiting to be operated under GA. The department had organized preconference course on Imaging in OMFS with hands an and also a marathon to create awareness. The department conducted a CDE program on Head & Neck cancer and signed an MOU with Gleneagles Global Institute of Oncology. BLS program was conducted for 3rd & 4th year students. Dr. S.

Jimson has participated in International Conference ICORS and presented a paper and poster. Casualty Postings for CRRI has been initiated and the students handled 33 patients in April and 120 in May. There were 14 Impactions done by CRRI in April and 11 in May. Scientific presentation in 4 intercollegiate programs were 12 and 2 awards were received. There are 8 ongoing and 10 completed studies and 9 published of them. All CRRI are guided by the staff for publication and 43 articles are expected to be published. Future programs of the department are Cancer awareness program at Nagallapuram, Lecture/Camp for orthognathic surgery in nearby colleges, Live Surgical Workshop in November, Training for research and ethics committee members.

4. Public Health Dentistry

Anti Tobacco Counseling is regularly done with 67 in April & 70 in May. Tobacco cessation training was attended by staff and students of the department. An international award was won from NIDA International forum by Dr. Delfin Lovelina for substance abuse awareness creation. 22 student participated in 4 intercollegiate competitions won 8 awards. If the various surveys done 2 has been published with students name and 3 waiting for publication. 2 more projects are yet to be finalized. There were 16 camps conducted during April & May. Programs conducted in the department includes world cancer day at college, world Health day celebrations at Oldage home, world No Tobacco day at Abirami Mega Mall and at Durgai Amman Temple. Future projects are camps at Police Academy & NSG and other factories. Full fledged Tobacco Cessation clinic with free Nicotine chewing gum from cipla to be started and Permanent Museum arrangement. The department is also Planning for a Tobacco Quit mobile app in Tamil.

5. Oral Pathology

Seminars presented by students were 8 in April & 7 in May, Biopsy 20 in April & 22 in May, Cytology 82 in April & 88 in May, Haematology 140 in April & 150 in May, ground sections 30 in April, 24 in May. No of OMFS cases reported were 4 in April, 5 in May, Tobacco associated lesions were 8 and 10 respectively. 27 students participated in 4 intercollegiate compititions 6 person were awarded. There were 7 interesting cases to diagnose like Mucormycosis, Fibrous dysplasia, Papillary Squamous cell carcinoma, Ameloblastoma, Peripheral ossifying fibroma and Leukoplakia. Department conducted Pre-Clinical skills competition in March and Dr. Makesh Raj attended a hands an course on Genetics at Shankara Netralaya in May. Future programs – Planning for CDE program with Oral Medicine in October / November and Intercollegiate competition for students.

6. Pedodontics

There was an increase of patient flow about 35 – 40 patients per day. There were 19 papers and poster presented in 4 intercollegiate competitions with 7 prizes awarded. Specialty treatment including Habit breaking appliance, Preventive Orthodontic treatment, minor surgical procedure and Dental Management of medically compromised patient were done in the departments. There were 3 publications in our college journal JCDUR one by staff and 2 by students. Future projections – preconference course on Biodentine an 13th September 2017, CDE program also in September and school dental Health programs. Full month rehabilitation also planned under GA.

7. Orthodontics

15 new cases were started in May with a collection of Rs. 81,400/-. Provided Multi-Disciplinary treatment and referred 2 cases to periodontics, 2 to Conservative Dentistry and 2 to Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery. New cases were given to CRRI for record writing and creation of case sheets with model analysis and Cephalometric tracing. Special case of congenitally missing lateral incisor where canine was converted to lateral by reshaping was done. Q-Jam - Clinical quiz and just a minute intercollegiate competition was conducted in March 2017. There were 5 student presentations and 2 prizes obtained in inter collegiate competitions. Future projections - set a target of Minimum Rs.80,000/-per month collection, fix more micro implants, planning for a CDE program along with IDA, Madras Branch in August. Dr. Job Jacob Anision is planning to attend CDE course on Biomedical waste management conducted by the University and Dr. Sunil is attending a Comprehensive Training on Contemporary Functional Appliance Mumbai in July. The department in planning to conduct awareness programs in Orthodontic treatment in the nearby colleges.

8. Conservative Dentistry

The income generated in April was Rs.69,870/- and May was Rs.76,750/-. Four faculties from the department attended the International Conference in Endodontics in New Delhi and Dr. Balagopal chaired a Keynote address and 3 staff members presented papers with conference. 7 student presentations in 2 inter collegiate competition produced 4 prizes, 3 research works have been completed and awaiting for publication. Dr. Balagopal was a faculty in National meet at Bengaluru on 29, 30th April and in Dubai in April 2017. Organized "Predictable Endodontics" CDE program with Dr. Praveen Kumar and Sponsored by Coltene Whaledent. Future planning – Six research proposals are to be initiated in the department. Dr. Balagopal

plans to visit few dental schools in USA and also look for future collaborations. The department is planning to conduct a certified course in Basic & Advanced Endodontics for a fee in future.

9. Prosthodontics

The total collection for April & May was Rs. 91,780/ -and Rs. 1,14,000/- respectively and FPD done in the two months were 70 and 78. 12 students placed implants successfully in the basic Implant course. Dr. Venkatakrishnan was a faculty in the TNIPS conference conducted at SRM, Ramapuram and he along with Dr. Pradeep took a lecture on Comprehensive Review program at Vel Dental College. There was an article published by Dr. Jacob and 5 articles have been submitted for publication. Two obturator cases were done and student Mukilan fabricated denture in Neutral Zone. 6 Journal clubs were conducted and one survey is being done. 23 students presented papers and posters in 3 inter collegiate competition and 9 of them won prize. Future projections – Dr. Venkatakrishnan will be attending PG convention at Rishikesh. The department is planning a video on step by step CD preparation for the students. Preconference course in ISPRP is being planned in August.
