# The HOD meeting was conducted on 23.01.2018 at 10.30 A.M. at the Principals Chamber.

- 1. Request all departments to kindly not send patients to Principals room for treatment concessions. Monitor regularly and see that patients do not wait for a long time.
- 2. To Prepare a list of Emergency drugs that has be purchased and send them to Pharmacy. To check for expiry dates of all drugs regularly.
- 3. Many departments have not sent in their students research work for grant approval. Requested them to send them at the earliest.
- 4. Discussed the usage of cell phone by students to call for patients. The students should all the patients in front of the staff in the department and not in the corridor.
- 5. Students performances, attendance and internal assessment marks were discussed and advised on the students who are eligible for University Exams.
- 6. The member of working hours in the clinic by the students was less than prescribed norms of Dental Council of India. It was agreed that the number of theory classes per week to be altered as follows the speciality of Orthodontia, Pedodontia, Oral Medicine and Public Health Dentistry will have one hour of theory per week and the specialities of Periodontia, Prosthodontia, Oral Surgery and Conservative Dentistry to have 2 hrs of theory per week. There will be extended OP hours on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday till 3 P.M.
- 7. The conference incentives of the various staff members were discussed. The Academic Council has approved the incentives of Dr. S. Jimson Rs. 10,000/-, Dr. C.J. Venkata Krishnan Rs.7,500/- Dr. Bhuvaneshwari and Dr. Juala Catherine Rs.7,500/- each and Dr. Delfine Lovelina only Rs. 10,000/- (as it was not a specialty conference conducted by an organization of repute)
- 8. Some of the staff were attending college for 5 days a week and hence their member of leave days will be proportionately reduced.

- 9. Chairperson had mooted the idea of conducting sports and cultural Inter Dental Meet. Since the college does not have a big auditorium it was decided that only sport competitions could be conducted. The Physical Director Mr. Natarajan was requested to send a proposal to conduct on sports meet in the beginning of March.
- 10. The Preclinical skills competition for this year was discussed and suggested March 8th OR 9th for the competition was planned to conduct quiz competition and paper and poster presentation along with Preclinical skills competition. Each department had been allotted work, which will be discussed further.
- 11. The students who work late in the departments must get a note of permission from the concerned staff of the department if they are late for the next class.
