ANTI - RAGGING COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT 2023

- The first meeting for the year 2023 was presided by the Principal and chairman of Anti-Ragging Committee Dr.C.J.Venkatakrishnan on 23.1.2023. Agenda of the Meeting was to discuss the measures being taken to prevent ragging in our Institution/Campus and enforce protocols, steps to safe guard the newly admitted Students of Ist year BDS.
- Staff Members, student's representatives given In charge as Anti Ragging committee and Squad help us to ensure students safety and welfare in the Hostel, Campus and the Surrounding areas of the institution.
- Punishments for ragging as per the regulations have been posted on notice boards.
- Measures being taken to prevent ragging in our institution/campus and enforce protocols, steps to safe guard the new admission students for next academic year.

KEY POINTS DISCUSSED:

- Anti-Ragging Squad advised for patrolling the college and the common areas in the academic/administrative / hostel/ mess of the institution, maintain vigilance at all times on all days by rotation.
- The display boards are updated with the new members list and their contact numbers.
- The anti ragging squad will make surprise raids in and around the college premises like canteen, hostel, mess, class rooms etc.,
- Measures being taken to prevent ragging in our Institution/Campus and enforce protocols, steps to safe guard the newly admitting Students of First year BDS.
- Five boards with the names of committee members and squad members with their contact numbers are to be placed in the common areas of the campus.
- Squad members are instructed to go surprise visits and to take geotagged photos when they go for rounds. They should put entry in the anti ragging squad register periodically.

- One Post graduate student has to include in the committee. One parent of newly joined students has to be include in the committee
- Members have to send a regret letter if not able to attend the meeting. Monthly report has to be made along with the photos.
- Name of the students and parents members have to include in the anti ragging letter head with designation.

PROGRAMS CONDUCTED:

- **“Orientation Program”** for First year BDS (2022 – 2023 batch) Students was held on 12/12/23. Anti ragging brochure distributed during the event. Anti Ragging oath was taken by senior interns. Freshers were educated about the institutional anti ragging committee and its role. Dr.G.S.Asokan, Professor and Head of the Department, Oral medicine and Radiology, Anti ragging committee member, addressed the students in the orientation program and educated them about their rights against ragging. Committee and anti ragging squad members were introduced.
- **“Orientation Program”** for First year BDS (2023 – 2024 batch) Students was held on 20/09/2023. Anti ragging brochure distributed during the event. Anti Ragging oath was taken by senior interns. Anti Ragging Program was conducted in the 1st Year BDS Orientation Programme held on 21/09/2023. Dr.G.S.Asokan, Professor and Head of the Department of oral medicine and radiology, Anti ragging committee member, had given lecture on menace of ragging .Committee and anti ragging squad members were introduced.
- **MENACE OF RAGGING** program was conducted for First year BDS (2022 – 2023 batch) Students on 1-02-2023 at 12 PM by Prof. Dr. Ida de Noronha de Ataide, M.D.S., Dean, Goa Dental College and Hospital, DCI Member in the auditorium through online. She enumerated cases of Ragging among various parts of India. She explained the ways to handle the Ragging scenario. She emphasised on the measures of prohibition of Ragging at the Institutional Level such as setting up anti- ragging committees, squads, monitoring cell.
- **MENACE OF RAGGING** program was conducted for First year BDS (2022 – 2023 batch) Students on 13-03-2023 at 12 PM by Dr.S.M.Balaji, MDS, MFDS,

RCPS(GLASG), PhD, DSc(HON), Director of Balaji Dental and Craniofacial Hospital, **DCI Member** spoke about the Meaning of ragging, Origin of Ragging, other terms of ragging. He explained the ways to handle the ragging scenario. He also explained about various types of Ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging. He also provided the helpline numbers available for protection against ragging. He concluded his talk by emphasizing to the students on the fact "SAY NO TO RAGGING".

- Dr.C.J.Venkatakrishnan, Principal, Chairman of Anti ragging committee has delivered Anti Ragging Oath followed by CRRI students before the gatherings. At the end of the program, all the Anti Ragging Squad members self introduced themselves to the speaker. Dr.G.S.Asokan, Head of the department, Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology, Member, Anti-Ragging Committee concluded the program by expressing gratitude to the speaker and the participants.
- **MENACE OF RAGGING** program was conducted for First year BDS (2023 – 2024 batch) Students on 23-12-2023 at 12 PM by **Dr.S.P. K. Kennedy Babu, M.D.S.**, Professor and Head, Department of Periodontology, Dean of Mahatma Gandhi Postgraduate Institute of Dental Sciences (MGPGI), **DCI Member** in the auditorium. He suggested about the ways to prevent ragging such as providing separate hostel block for freshers, Surprise visit by the higher authorities, complaint boxes can be kept. He also explained about various types of Ragging, punishable ingredients of ragging.
- Dr.G.S.Asokan, Head of the department, Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology, Member, Anti-Ragging Committee has delivered Anti Ragging Oath followed by CRRI students before the gatherings. At the end of the program, all the Anti Ragging Squad members self introduced themselves to the speaker. 
ACTIONS TAKEN:

- The anti ragging squad made surprise raids in and around the college premises like canteen, hostel, mess, class rooms etc.
