ANTI - RAGGING COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT 2021-22

- The first meeting for the year 2022 was presided by the Principal and chairman of Anti-Ragging Committee Dr.C.J.Venkatakrishnan on 7.2.2022. Agenda of the Meeting was to discuss the measures being taken to prevent ragging in our Institution/Campus and enforce protocols, steps to safe guard the newly admitted Students of Ist year BDS.
- Staff Members, student's representatives given in charge as Anti Ragging committee and Squad help us to ensure students safety and welfare in the Hostel, Campus and the Surrounding areas of the institution. Any mischievous behavior shall be liable for punishment as per university
- Punishments for ragging as per the regulations have been posted on notice boards.

KEY POINTS DISCUSSED:

- Anti-Ragging Committee and the squad made sufficient visits to both the boys and girls hostels at any given time. The function of Anti-Ragging Squad advised for patrolling the college and the common areas in the academic/administrative / hostel/ mess of the institution, maintain vigilance at all times on all days by rotation.
- Measures being taken to prevent ragging in our institution/campus and enforce protocols, steps to safe guard the new admission students for next academic year.
- Suggestions were given to involve the 2nd and 3rd year undergraduates in routine basis for the anti ragging committee programs.
- Anti-Ragging squad patrolling the college and the common areas in regular manner and entered in register. Vigilance maintained at all times on all days by rotation.

PROGRAMS CONDUCTED:

- "Orientation Program" for First year BDS Students was held on 13th APRIL 2022 and 13th December 2022. Fresher's were educated about the institutional anti ragging committee and its role. Dr.G.S.Asokan, Professor and Head of the Department, Oral medicine and Radiology addressed the students in the orientation program and educated them about their rights against ragging.
- MENACE OF RAGGING program was conducted on 13.5.2022
- Dr.C.J.Venkatakrishnan, Principal, Head of the department Department of Prosthodontics, Chairman Anti-Ragging Committee welcomed the speaker and the students and gave an introduction about the topic of the day.
- The speaker **Dr.B.Rajkumar** spoke about the Meaning of ragging. He enumerated cases of Ragging among various parts of India. He explained the ways to handle the Ragging scenario. He suggested about the ways to prevent ragging. He also explained about variouspunishable ingredients of ragging. He emphasised on the measures of prohibition of Ragging at the Institutional Level such as setting up anti-ragging committees, squads, monitoring cell etc..
- Google feedback form link for the program were sent to the students who attended it and responses were received.
- Anti-Ragging squad patrolling the college and the common areas in regular manner and entered in register. Vigilance maintained at all times on all days by rotation.
