ANNUAL REPORT 2022 – 2023

KEY NOTES OF THE MEETING:

- New batch (2022 – 23) of First BDS 79 students joined on 12.12.2022. Eight mentors allotted for the fresh year students.
- New batch (2023 – 24) of 100 First BDS students joined on 21.2.2023. Ten mentors allotted for the fresh year students.
- Mentor mentees and parents whatsapp group have started to post attendance, terminal exam schedule and marks.
- Mentors are instructed to verify mentees and their parent's details that entered in mentorship card.
- The mentors will be in charge of communicating with parents regarding attendance and marks of their respective mentees.
- Postgraduate students took revision classes for certain topics for duration of one week.
- Mentors are requested to meet their mentees on weekly basis and check their progress.
- Mentors are requested to follow up students and motivate them for model and university examination.
- Three terminal and model examinations have been conducted and marks were informed to respective wards parents.
- Staffs requested for offline PTA meeting during weekdays.
- Students have to register for next academic year after university exam irrespective of result.
- Students were instructed to collect their books and instruments.
- Students have to do NPTEL exam registration.
- One parent requested for daily attendance.

- Few students have low percentage of attendance.
- 5 PTA meeting were conducted through online mode and 4 meeting were conducted through offline mode. Students attended the meeting with their parents. Students and parents grievances forwarded to respective committees.
- Student's attendance average calculated for the past four months. Those who have attendance percentage below 80%, informed to their respective parents.
- Seven students have very low percentage attendance in anatomy department. Head of the department instructed their respective parents to meet him.
- Replacement of Dr.Kumararaja by Dr.Nandhini. .
- Students were availing too many days leave. Approval of HODs for leave letter is mandatory before they get the mentor sign.
- Scholarship Students are instructed to pay pending fees on or before July 31st 2023.
- Pathology HOD complained about poor performance of the students in terminal exams.
- Students have instructed to inform their mentors prior when they go for extracurricular activities.
- College reopens on 4/9/2023 for third year additional batch students for final year.
- Fees pending students have to pay on or before October 24th.
- Few parents have complained about water leakage in girl's hostel bathroom.
- Model practical exam timetable was rescheduled for final year BDS students due to college cultural.
- Final year additional batch student's normal class schedule started.
- Re model exam will be conducted for first year students from 30th October 2023 for absentees and failed students in model exams.
- University exam going to start for first year students from December 14th 2023 and informed to mentees and their parents.
- University practical exam conducted for first year students from 8th to 11th January and information given to mentees.

- Holidays will be from 12th January for first year students and second year classes will start from 29nd January, irrespective of results.


STUDENTS GRIEVANCES COLLECTED DURING THIS ACADEMIC YEAR:

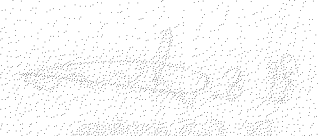
